### **PLEASE NOTE**

- Centre number should be 5 characters i.e BW plus the three digit centre number.
- Candidate number should be 4 numeric characters.
- The surname is not cAsE sensitive.
- After sending your enquiry please allow few minutes to receive a response. Response may be delayed due to congestion in the lines.
- Access of results through SMS is valid for 7 days from the publishing date.

# The meaning of 'X' and 'U' symbol in grades (SMS and Website)

- U denotes that a candidate failed to meet minimum requirements for grade
- 2. X denotes that a candidate failed to meet the requirements for the award of
- 3. Q denotes that results are being withheld until investigations are complete.

# CESS YOUR BGCSE RESULTS THROUGH

BGCSE results are also available from BEC website (www.bec.co.bw) and can be accessed as follows:

1. Open the web browser (Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome) and type www.bec.co.bw to open the Botswana Examinations Council website.



2. Click on the "Results

(The navigator bar is the blue bar that starts with the "home" tab, and also has the "About BEC" tab, "Qualifications" tab, etc")



3. Click "My Results" on the gold navigation bar that pops up.

Here you can find your examination results dating as far back as 2009. Make sure to fill in all the fields.

# 4. Examination

In the "Examination" drop down combo box, select the Examination (in this case select BGCSE)

#### 5. Year

The year in which the examination occured.



In the "Year" drop down combo box, select the Year (in this case select 2024)

#### 6. Centre

The centre number

In the "Centre Number" textbox type your Centre Number.

Centre Number should be 5 characters i.e BW plus the three digit centre number. For example, if your Centre Number is 800 you type BW800. The system will **not accept** centre number without the prefix **BW**.

### 7. Candidate Id

The student's candidate number

In the "Candidate Id" textbox type your Candidate Number. The system accepts a Candidate Number with leading zeros and without leading zeros. For example, if your Candidate Number is 0001, you may type 0001 or 001 or 01 or 1 and the system will accept any of them.

# 8. Candidate Surname The candidate's Surname

In the "Surname" text box type your Surname. The Surname is not Case Sensitive.

### 9. Show results

Click the "Show Results" button. This should display your results indicating the Exam Level, Year, Centre/School, subjects and their grades.
