Note:

An Inspector of Factories has the power to examine any person employed in a factory or in certain other occupations and to require every such person to be so examined and to sign a declaration of the truth of the matters respecting which he is so examined; but a person is not required to answer any question or to give any evidence tending to incriminate himself/herself. Penalties: For obstructing an Inspector – a fine of Fifty Rand and to imprisonment for two months.
